Dear Mr. Friedman:

On Friday, July 17, 2009, representatives of the Los Feliz Improvement Association met with Mike Cho, VP of Marketing for Tangier and with Steve S. Kim, President of gsd partners, inc., Tangier's consultant.

Both Mr. Kim and Mr. Cho advised us that Tangier would no longer offer live entertainment at the location. They also offered to request another compliance hearing after the new Tangier has been in operation for six months.

We request that the Office of the Zoning Administrator schedule another compliance hearing to take place during six months to one year after the new Tangier Restaurant opens. At that point the community will be able to determine the impact of removing live entertainment from the venue. We understand that existing conditions will remain in place. We also ask that you require Tangier to post a sign and verbally remind patrons not to park on the nearby residential streets.
