An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) is being prepared for improvements proposed for the Glendale-Hyperion Viaduct Complex. The complex includes six structures but only the Glendale Boulevard (northbound and southbound) and Hyperion structures are currently proposed for major improvement together with a cosmetic improvement to the Waverly Avenue Bridge.

A public scoping meeting is required under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) to obtain your views of the proposed project and suggestions you might have for its improvement. Your input is very important and will be used to prepare the upcoming Environmental Impact Report (EIR). *You are encouraged to attend! Please come, ask questions and express your opinions.*
